DPN Peer to Peer Pilot

We are facilitating a pilot during which:

Members with large data transfer and preservation needs can explore the processes and policies needed to support their activities.

Purpose:

- Capture metadata required for large data transfers amongst peers;
- Evaluate legal frameworks and agreements;
- Examine how transactions would be facilitated by DPN;
- Consider policy and service implications.

DPN Peer to Peer Pilot (cont.)

Four areas of work are identified

- Tools Identification
- Policies
- Legal Framework
- DPN Technical Role

Bag Size Pilot

The current bag size limit is 250GB.

This poses problems for large objects that cannot be reliably ‘chunked’ or datasets that may be encrypted or serialized by the depositor.

Our goals for the pilot are:

1. Remove the explicit limit of 250GB for ingest and replication operations
2. Perform a series of transfers to exercise the larger bag sizes
3. Identify and remove any embedded constraints
4. Demonstrate the reliability of transfer and ingest of large bags
